

Wi-Fi Security Tips

- Keep Windows and Internet Explorer patches up to date.
- Keep Anti-Virus Software up to date.
- Keep Firewall Software up to date.
- Keep Anti-SpyWare Software up to date.
- Do not access open or adhoc networks.
- When using public Wi-Fi, use your corporate VPN for any link back to your company.
- Make sure all your traffic is individually encrypted. Do not use regular POP3, IMAP, or SMTP for e-mail. Better solutions are SSL encrypted such as POP3 over SSL (POP3S), IMAP over SSL (IMAPS), and SMTP over SSL (SMTPS/SMTP TLS).
- Cellular data networks provide a slightly higher technical barrier than Wi-Fi, but be sure to take precautions.
